GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

Dear participant:

In order for your summary to be quickly accepted and processed, we would appreciate your attention to the following instructions:

The abstracts will consist of a maximum of 300 words (including title), typed at a single space, in Times New Roman font, size 10, in Microsoft Word or another compatible with it. Everything justified.

Title of the paper: in bold capitals, in Spanish or English, as appropriate (its translation in parenthesis, standard letter, case sensitive. Provide the full names of the authors and their email addresses. If two surnames, merge them with a hyphen. Underline the name of the author who will attend the Event.

Leave a space.

The Abstract must be informative, containing: Objectives, Materials and Methods, Results and Conclusions. No subtitles (eg. INTRODUCTION, etc.), or References.

Each poster display will be 120 cm tall x 90 cm wide mounted vertically.

All abstracts must be sent to the Organizing Committee through the web site www.sanidadagropecuaria.com or to the email sis2019@censa.edu.cu, before February 15, 2019. They will be evaluated by a Scientific Committee of experts for final approval.
