- 1. The meeting was called to order by President A. H. Ellingboe at 4:00 p.m.
- 2. R. D. Wilcoxson, University of Minnesota, was appointed as parliamentarian.

 - a. Council has authorized a Publications Coordinating Committee to assist in the planning of all future publications of the Society. The committee will be chaired by T. Kommedahl and members of the committee will include the chairmen of committees dealing with publications.
 - b. The Compendium of Wheat Diseases, edited by M. V. Wiese, Michigan State University, will be published in September. The next compendium in the series will be on alfalfa diseases, followed by a compendium on potato diseases.
 - c. Monograph 10. Phytophthora root rot diseases by G. A. Zentmyer is in final manuscript form. This is the last publication authorized in the Monograph Series.
 - d. A new directory of the society membership will be distributed during September 1977. It will contain only the name, address and affiliation of each member.
 - e. The computer terminal is now operational in the Society Headquarters, This will provide billing services, membership lists, mailing lists, etc.
