

Cleora J. D'Arcy received her A.B. in Biology from Harvard University and her M.S. and Ph.D. in Plant Pathology from the University of Wisconsin - Madison. She is a Full Professor in the Department of Crop Sciences at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, where she teaches undergraduate and graduate courses on plant pathology and professionalism and ethics, and researches virus diseases of plants. Dr. D'Arcy has authored over 75 peer-reviewed publications on plant virology and teaching, and is co-editor of *Barley Yellow Dwarf: 40 Years of Progress*. She is a Past President of The American Phytopathological Society, a recipient of the NACTA Central Regional Outstanding Teacher Award and the National USDA/NASULGC Food and Agricultural Sciences Excellence in Teaching Award, and a Fellow of The American Phytopathological Society and the American Association for the Advancement of Science.
