## GENERAL PUBLICATION POLICIES

At least one author must be a member of The American Phytopathological Society, except to subscribing institution outside the United States or Canada may have published, by a staff member, on (in English) per volume. A letter of transmittal, signed by an official of the foreign institution, accompany such manuscripts.

Submission of manuscripts: Submit all new manuscripts to The American Phytopathological Editorial Office, 3340 Pilot Knob Road, St. Paul, Minn. 55121. Do not submit new manuscripts Editor-in-Chief. Submission implies nonsubmission elsewhere and (if accepted) no publication elsewhere same form without consent.

Subject matter should fall into the following categories: 1) Original research on some phase disease. 2) Review papers developing a new concept, hypothesis, theory, or other integration pathology. 3) Phytopathological Notes: These are accounts of techniques, original research phytopathological history of general importance, but sufficiently brief (1-4 typed pages) as not toll published pages. 4) Letters to the Editor: These may explain, amplify, or otherwise comment upon published in the journal or elsewhere. Letters to the editor are reviewed in the same manner a contributions, and the Editorial Board reserves the right to reject or to publish letters of rebut appropriate.

Page charge: A charge of \$35 per published page will apply to all manuscripts submitted by author obituaries and those submitted in response to invitation by the Society after March 1, 1973.

Separates: No free copies supplied. Reprints will be available at a nominal cost; quotation will be proof.

For style details, follow: Author's Guide for Manuscript Preparation, Phytopathology 62:1-4,1 Style Manual for Biological Journals (latest edition). Amer. Inst. Biol. Sci., Washington, D.C. Au urged to have one or more colleagues read the manuscript critically prior to submission.

Use of material in Phytopathology: Phytopathology is not copyrighted, but those who wish II illustrations or data appearing in Phytopathology for use in other publications should obtain the per the author of the paper, and provide a line crediting Phytopathology as the source of the material.
