New Book Provides Diagnostic, Management Aid for Soybean Pests

- Strategies for disease management, including biological enhancements, cultural practices, host-plant resistance, and pesticide use

The Compendium of Soybean Diseases and Pests, Fifth Edition also includes an introduction that provides background information about the history and growth of the soybean plant along with a contemporary discussion of the importance of soybean pathogens and pests in the world's chief soybean-producing countries.

Several appendices help the reader identify pathogens of soybeans, insects associated with soybean, and hosts of soybean pathogens. A comprehensive glossary and index are provided, as well.

The Compendium of Soybean Diseases and Pests, Fifth Edition is the authoritative guide for researchers, growers, and other professionals in agribusiness, consulting, extension, and

regulatory. This book is particularly useful for scientists who need an authoritative reference on diseases and practitioners who need or provide management recommendations.
