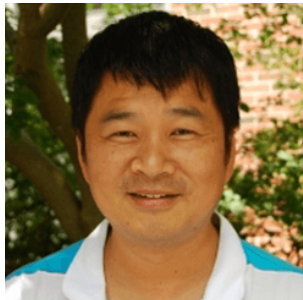


BACTERIAL DISEASES: PAST, PRESENT, AND FUTURE

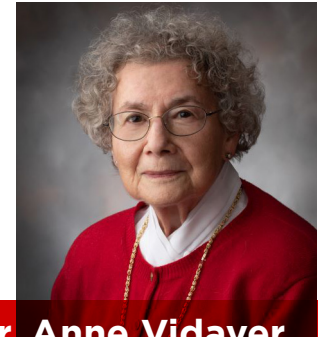
