Meeting Objective

- 1. Based on the findings provided, what insights can be gained from the data collected?

- 3. What types of activities is your company/organization undertaking to increase the ag science talent pool? Are the activities directed at specific audiences (e.g. K-12, undergraduate, graduate, customers) or the general public?
- 4. If CSAW is a viable outlet for helping address industry talent needs, who should be the audience for the message from this unique partnership of scientific societies and corporations to facilitate ensuring there will be sufficient numbers of trained science professionals for the food and agriculture system?
- 5. For the next one and two years, what are the most appropriate scope, focus and critical steps for CSAW?
- 6. Are companies and scientific societies willing to financially support and participate in CSAW going forward with these next steps?
