Pesticide Resistance

 Resistance is the significant and heritable decreased sensitivity of a pest to a pesticide.



What is Resistance Management?

 Resistance management is both reactive strategies to mitigate existing pesticide resistance and proactive initiatives to prevent future pesticide resistance development.



Achievements To-Date

 Voluntary labeling guidelines developed with Canada's PMRA

PR Notice 2001-5 issued

OPP Resistance Management Workgroup formed



What is OPP focusing on?

- Addressing resistance management issues in decision-making processes
- Working collaboratively with stakeholders to address resistance management issues in an effective way
- Promoting stewardship efforts

- Examine international approaches for resistance management initiatives

- Develop strategic plan for addressing pesticide resistance issues
